HOW FOOD CAN SAVE THE WORLD

CAROLYN STEEL AUTHOR

We live in a world shaped by food – a 'sitopia', or food-place (from Greek sitos, food + topos, place), but since we don't value food, we live in a bad one which – as the current pandemic has highlighted – threatens both our future and that of the planet. In this talk, Carolyn Steel will explain how, by valuing food again, we can not only rebuild our lives and world better after Covid, but can create a new idea of a good life fit for the 21st Century.

Carolyn Steel is a leading thinker on food and cities.

Her 2008 book **Hungry City: How Food Shapes Our Lives** is an international bestseller and established her concept of sitopia (food-place) across a broad range of fields in academia, industry and the arts. A Rome scholar in 1995-6, Carolyn is in international demand as a speaker and her 2009 TED talk has received more than one million views. Her second book **Sitopia: How Food Can Save the World**, was published by Chatto & Windus in March 2020.
