PRACTICAL INFORMATION

ARRIVAL & TRANSFER

The easiest way to get to **Malmö (Sweden)** is to arrive at **Copenhagen Airport (Denmark)** and then take the train.

Trains from the airport to **Malmö Central Station** every 20 min. It takes 25 minutes and costs SEK 129 (\in 13). The hotel is located 5 minutes walk from the station.
